

Results of DMA show relative strengths of capabilities and variability across the system

DMA scores across the What Good Looks Like dimensions²



ICS scores across all 7 WGLL dimensions on the core DMA survey¹ help to target areas to “level-up”



1. Average score as scored by individual ICSs; This score is not the aggregate of provider scores within an ICS

2. Scores are weighted according to a methodology that estimates the relative value of each of the 50 capabilities described in the DMA; analysis on DMA results was conducted across 6 different weighting methodologies – results needed to be robust to all six to be included in the final analysis pack. An overview of these weighting methodologies can be found in the appendix

What it was like then.

- In looking back even further I remember in Worcester Acute in the year 2000 the national programme



- The techy stuff and systems were designed by techy people
- Doctors? They treated patients.....



Step back in time 10+ years

What it was like then.

- Senior folk were Directors there were no 'Chiefs' other than the CEO.



- IT was about the boxes and wires, what was digital?



Step back in time 10+ years

What it was like then.

- A clinical system was seen as something that had to be filled in rather than an enabler
- There was a feeling of so much potential and that digitising and having medical records electronic could fundamentally change the way hospitals were run.



Step back in time 10+ years

What it was like then.

- By a stroke of luck organisations that went alone at the time, ended up ahead digitally.
- Systems were disparate and separate the need to fully integrate was not understood properly, certainly the word interoperability was phrase not used in this area.



Step back in time 10+ years

What it was like then.

- A clinician and I started using the data to measure what happened to patients after they left the hospital and lucky enough to get a national award for it.
- There was a discovery that other digital leaders in other hospitals had similar challenges and a realisation that there was strength in numbers and working closer together.





Step back in time 10+ years

What it was like then.

Around 50 of us met in Oxford over 2 days to set out how can we work together to support each other, influence the centre, create career paths, and drive on digital maturity.



The 'Newcastle Declaration' – why citizens need far better information sharing across health and social care.

The 'Newcastle Declaration', jointly developed by front line clinical information leaders from across the NHS, at the 2015 CCIO Network Summer School, Newcastle, calls for a radical step change on interoperability (information sharing between different electronic systems) to enable truly joined up health and social care.

“We declare that, in order to provide safe and effective health and care for all citizens, health and care professionals require unimpeded access to all relevant information available on those they care for.

“Too often, health and care professionals today lack key information available on those they care for, and have to make treatment decisions without access to all of the currently available knowledge, such as previous care and test results. Citizens and
